# Course Summary

Course Description	American Cultural Studies (미국문화연구) is an introductory course focusing on how varyin g aspects of American cultural have influenced not only the social structure of the United S tates but also the world. Rather than simply examining the influence that American culture has had on society, this course also takes a critical approach through the analysis of disc ourses that have shaped America and its complex relations with both the American people and the world. Central themes associated with American cultural studies that will be discu ssed include the various ways in which these themes can be interpreted. These themes, essential interlocking aspects of what have created American identity, include gender and society, the representation of youth, American global influence, regional differences in term s of culture, and the impact of the American city on cultural values. Discussions will focus on how different aspects of American culture such as film, modern art, architecture, music, and media have contributed to these themes.
Description Related Courses	This class will consist of more than simple, straight-forward lectures. Although lectures ar e a component of the course, they will be integrated with discussions, activities, assignme
