Course Summary

Course Description	Creative & Discursive Writing 2 (창작과논술 2) is designed for high-intermediate to advance d university-level academic writing for English learners. This course focuses on developin g rhetoric and sentence structure in a straightforward manner, using a step-by-step appro ach and varied practices. You will be guided through the writing process to produce well-organized, adequately developed paragraphs and essays. Explanations are simple, and n umerous opportunities for practice will help you assimilate each writing skill effectively.
Description Related Courses	The topics listed for each writing activity are only suggestions, and ultimately will be decid ed by you. Group prewriting and in-class writing of first drafts will be used, as I will be av ailable for immediate consultation. Also, I will check to make sure everyone is on the right t rack. Pair and group collaboration is appropriate for prewriting and editing work; however, writing is essentially an individual task even when done in class.

Course Goals	The overall goal of this course is for students to produce academic-level writing though eff ective use of sentence structure, paragraph formation and organization, and essay development.
Projected Result	By the end of the semester, the students should be able to develop their writing through re asoning and critical thinking in a clear and persuasive manner.
Percentage of the e original language classes(%)	For the most part, this course will be taught completely in English. This class uses English as the medium of instruction (EMI), so it is expected that the students taking this class are fluent English speakers. I understand that a majority of the students are not native English speakers, so I will do my best to communicate in a clear manner. If there are any issues in understanding the lesson due to any language barriers, don't hesitate to ask me to clarify anything that may be difficult for you to understand.
