Course Summary

Course Description	Employment and Career Seminar 1 (취창업 • 진로세미나1) is a course designed to help you make the most out of your college experience so that you can successfully transition to a fulfilling career most appropriate for you. Focus is placed on how to find the best career path based on a number of variables including your major, your interests, your values, and your skill set. There will be a number of introspective activities in this course that are designed to bring out your unique skills and knowledge, and help you in the process of preparing for a career after college. Some specific areas of focus include using appropriate resource s to plan for a career, knowing the employment landscape, and highlighting your strengths through the development of a resume.
Description Related Courses	Although lectures are a component of the course, they will be integrated with discussions, activities, assignments, and group work. The DKU e-learning campus will be used as an online portion of the class, where assignments can be completed. I believe it is my job to h

It is also important to note that there will be several times throughout the semester in which a special instructor will appear and present information from a Korean employment and car eer perspective.
Course Goals	This course is basically designed to help you gain insight on ways in which you can succ essfully transition from college to career. The main focus of evaluation is on displaying you r ability to apply concepts to real-life situations in ways that will promote a successful car eer path in post-college life. Although the class is taught in English, this is not a grammar class, and emphasis is placed on the development of your ideas through the principles as sociated with career success.
