| Course Description          | The purpose of this course is to provide a comprehensive framework for the analysis of contemporary public international law , by drawing upon various theories and cases. Given that international society is developing rapidly, proper understanding of international community from the legal perspective will be essential for understanding the nature of international society.  |
| Description Related Courses | This course should be understood as an essential part of legal studies on international society. As the concept of state sovereignty is subject to change according to the change of the nature of international society over time, having some knowledge of diplomatic history is also essential for studies of public international law . This course is closely related to settlement of international disputes, international trade law , international human rights law and international law seminar. |
| Course Goals                | The goal of this course is to provide law students with normative foundations and principles for assessing international legal issues. As this course will focus on the understanding   |
